Proposed By-Law Change of Mt. Sinai Shriners #3

This proposal will be voted on at the Mt. Sinai Fall Ceremonial on Oct. 19, 2019.

Presently per Article II Section 3 -- Mt. Sinai's annual election of officer's occurs at the Annual Meeting in January. The following change to the By-Laws would alleviate any embarrassment and heart ache on the day of elections.

New By-Law change would be the following: Article II Section 3a.

Election of Officers shall occur in the month of December at the stated meeting known as Chief Rabban Day.

Section 3b. Annual Meeting Date and Location.

The first stated meeting of each calendar year must be held in January within jurisdiction of the Center. And be designated as the Annual Meeting, at which meeting shall be the installing of the Officers of the Center and the Representative to Shriners International.


